Election Procedure Overview: The election procedure for State Office is as follows: 1) Eligible candidates will complete and send their applications to the State Office*; 2) The candidates will take the FCCLA knowledge test and deliver their nomination speeches at the State Leadership Conference; 3) Voting Delegates will review their applications and select the officers to serve as the State Executive Council; 4) Final assignment of officer positions will be made following the election process outlined in the state policies with the newly elected State Executive Council.

*Qualifying candidates will receive confirmation of receipt from the State Office soon after the February 1 postmarked deadline.
